

Theramex introduces the Birth initiative for funding research in the field of reproductive medicine.

In April 2019, Theramex has introduced Birth (Better Innovation and Research with Theramex). Through Birth, Theramex is offering funding for a project that aims to improve the treatment of people undergoing fertility treatment with Assisted Reproduction Techniques (ART).

Researchers or clinicians in Europe, who are working in a reproductive medicine academic unit, or in an ART clinic or research centre can apply for a Birth grant between April and September 1st, 2019. The proposals will be reviewed by a dedicated committee who will award grants for the best projects in December 2019.

By launching this initiative, Theramex intends to stand by its commitment to furthering the knowledge and treatments for fertility-related conditions, leading to improved treatment pathways and ultimately, better outcomes for patients and health care providers.
